## Description

The Vinaigrette is of broad rectangular, cushion, form. The plain silver sides display a serpentine shaped thumb piece and both the cover and base are inset with very unusually shaded, slightly domed, Scottish agate panels. The cover opens up to reveal a beautifully pierced and engraved grille displaying a floral spray including a harebell. This unusual Vinaigrette is in excellent condition. Although unmarked, this is almost certainly Scottish in origin. Length: 1.25 inches, 3.13 cm. Width: 1.00 inch, 2.5 cm. Height: 0.45 inches, 1.13 cm
