

A rare naturalistic Caddy Spoon made in Birmingham in 1852 by Hilliard & Thomason.

Description

The naturalistic twisted handle is decorated with applied flower heads and leaves. The gilded fluted bowl is also decorated with a flower head, flanked by foliate motifs. This is a known design from the workshops of Hilliard & Thomason and an identical example, of the same date, can be seen on plate 57 of *Caddy Spoons*, by Captain John Norie. Part of the makers mark is shown under the applied decoration.
