Description

The Vinaigrette is broad rectangular in form and is engraved all over with tartan pattern designs. This example displays a vacant shield shaped cartouche on the cover and a cast serpentine shaped thumbpiece. The interior is finely gilded and the grille is pierced and engraved with pluming scrolls and flower heads.
