Description

This fine Spoon is modelled in the elegant slender Old English Pattern. The top of the stem is engraved with an unusual contemporary raying shell Crest and this piece displays a good bowl, with thick tip to the end. The spoon is in excellent condition and is very well marked on the reverse.
