Description

These quality Tongs are modelled in the Fiddle and Thread pattern and display wide grips pierced with scrolls, stars and teardrop motifs, all surrounded by a linear engraved frame. The arch of the arms is engraved with a contemporary Crest and the tongs are very well marked. William Knight was an excellent maker of serving pieces, and slices, during the Georgian period. Length: 9.75 inches, 24.38 cm. Width of the grips: 1.6 inches, 4cm. Weight: 7oz.
