Description

This rare combination piece has a twisted stem and the circular crushing end is engraved with a set of contemporary script initials above the initial "W". This may well refer to the donor and the recipient. The stem is very well marked, unusually including two maker's marks, and is in excellent condition. Length: 5.5 inches, 13.75 cm.
