Description

The Vinaigrette is broad rectangular in form and is engraved on the cover with trellis work designs and stylised foliate motifs around a rectangular cartouche engraved with contemporary script initials. The base is engraved with a foliate spray and prick dot bands. The interior is finely gilded and the grille is pierced and engraved with pluming scrolls.
