Description

The Wine Label is cast and decorated all over with training vines and grapes. The scroll banner is pierced for MADEIRA and the button cartouche above is engraved with a contemporary Crest. The Crest is that of Coke, as used by the Earls of Leicester of Holkham Hall, Norfolk. The label is of an excellent gauge and weight. Length: 2.75 inches, 6.88 cm. Width: 2.25 inches, 5.63 cm.
