Short Description

The pierced trowel shaped blade is decoated with a central fish surrounded by a border of billowing water weeds. The blade also displays an outer band of trailing foliate scroll work. This example has an Old English Pattern handle, attached to the blade with a cast double shell moulding. The top of the stem is engraved with a contemporary Crest and the slice is very well marked on the reverse. This Slice is illustrated in Investing in Silver, by Eric Delieb, page 126.
