Short Description

This very rare Butter Spoon is modelled in the fiddle pattern, with typical raised rounded rectangular bowl. The top of the stem is engraved with a contemporary initial. Most unusually, the spoon is marked with Aberdeen marks, as well as being assayed in Edinburgh. These Butter Spoons were peculiar to Scotland, however to find a Provincial example is most unusual.
