Short Description

The Mustard Pot is modelled in the rare Drum form and has a plain body with reeded base and rim. The very high domed cover terminates in a bell finial and also has a reeded rim. The scroll handle displays a beautiful pierced fan shaped thumbpiece where it is attached to the cover. The side of the main body is engraved with the contemporary initial B and this piece has a blue glass liner. The Mustard Pot is in excellent condition and is fully marked on the base. This is an extremely scarce example of Newcastle silver and this unusual design was peculiar to this centre and examples are extremely rare - this being only the second which we have offered in nearly fifty years.
