Short Description

The Vinaigrette is modelled as a Bouncing Ball and is decoated with a central reeded band. The top and bottom is pierced with roundels and is engraved with unusual wriggle work designs. The central section unscrews so that the sponge can be inserted. Although unmarked, this rare design of Vinaigrette was made in the workshops of Cocks and Bettridge and examples are extremely rare. This piece is in excellent condition.
