Short Description

The Slice has a long oval flat blade which has a circumferential frieze of bright cutting and double wriggle work lines around a pierced, engraved, area of laurel leaves, swags and a central star burst. The un-pierced area is engraved, on both sides, with a Neo-Classical covered urn, above an oval boss engraved with a contemporary Crest. The waisted shank connects to a double beaded handle. A near identical example is shown in *Antique Silver Servers for the Dining Table*, by Benton Seymour Rabinovitch, page 123, figure 7.
