Short Description

This exceptionally rare spoon was used in the kitchen to measure out ingredients. The spoon is modelled in the fiddle pattern and displays a tablespoon sized bowl at one end and a teaspoon sized bowl at the other. The spoon is in excellent condition and is very well marked. A few of these spoons were made in London by George Adams, however we have never seen one coming from Scotland before.
